Principle

The committee will award its annual prizes against predetermined criteria. The aim is to reward members who actively support the club by participating in club events.

Criteria

Over all criteria. Must be a club member and hold residence with in HB, club members who are affiliated members from a different region will not be considered.

Performance of the Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Junior, senior, veteran or Legend • Male or Female 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club member <p><u>Hierarchy of criteria</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highest placing in elite or age group as a member of the selected New Zealand team at a World championship duathlon or triathlon (e.g. ITU, Kona, Challenge Events, WTC Events, Xterra) • Qualification for New Zealand team at a qualifying event for duathlon or triathlon (e.g. ITU, Kona or Xterra), combined with highest placing in age group. (Used when club members do not attend an international event) <p>OR – at the discretion of the committee if a significant performance has been achieved at any event(s)</p>
Volunteer of the Year –	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any member of person affiliated to the club (not club development manager) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Significant time put into club and national activity • Specialist skill recognised <p><i>(Note: the winner will also be considered for nomination for TriNZ national volunteer of the year)</i></p>
